

Air Data Management Project (ADMP) Update: Public Air Data Reporting Tools

Alberta Environment and Protected Areas (EPA) in collaboration with the Alberta Energy Regulator (AER), is releasing three new web-based reporting products for province-wide air quality and industry emissions data, as part of the Air Data Management Program (ADMP). These tools will make air data submitted to EPA under AER and EPA Environmental Enhancement and Protection Act (EPEA) Approvals, the Air Monitoring Directive (AMD) and the Alberta Continuous Emissions Monitoring System (CEMS) Code available publicly.

The following are the new products available to stakeholders:

- 1. Air Data Information Map on Alberta Geospatial Platform (AGSP)
- 2. Ambient Data Download
- 3. Continuous Emissions Monitoring System (CEMS) Data Download
